### **School and Community**

Foundation Academy, a Pre-K through 12th Grade private Christian school, has been serving the Winter Garden community since 1958. As a ministry of Winter Garden's First Baptist Church, Foundation Academy partners with families and the church to build a firm foundation for life through Christ-centered education. The school offers a comprehensive experience across its four campuses, including two lower schools, one upper school, and a fully online program for grades 6-12. The upper school is located on the Tilden Campus, a sprawling 70-acre property in southwest Orange County and serves students in grades 7 through 12. Enrolled students complete an admissions process that includes an application, schooladministered testing, student interview with Administration, and parent interview with Administration.

Foundation Academy's growth and success are intricately linked to the expansive suburban growth in Southwest Orange County and Eastern Lake County. This includes the dynamic Orlando Metropolitan area, which thrives on its diverse industries such as tourism, aerospace, entertainment, hospitality, and technology. This synergy between the school and its surrounding community fosters a rich and supportive atmosphere for students and families alike.

#### **Academic Program**

College Prep courses are the standard level for the high school curriculum. Honors, AP, and Dual Enrollment are available for core course placement as determined annually based on student grades, prior course levels, PSAT test scores, and department teacher recommendation. The most advanced classes available by grade:

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9th Grade: English I Honors, Geometry Honors, Biology I Honors, AP Human Geography, Spanish II or American Sign Language II, Bible I

**10th Grade**: English II Honors, Algebra II Honors, Chemistry Honors, AP World History or Dual Enrollment World Civilization I and II, Spanish III Honors or American Sign Language III Honors, Bible II

11th Grade: AP English Language or Dual Enrollment English Composition I and II, Pre-Calculus Honors or Statistics Honors, AP US History or Dual Enrollment American History I and II, AP level science, Spanish IV Honors or American Sign Language IV Honors, Bible III

12th Grade: AP English Literature or Dual Enrollment English Composition I and II, AP level math, AP level science, Dual Enrollment Macroeconomics, AP US Government & Politics or Dual Enrollment American Government, AP Spanish Language and Culture, Bible IV




